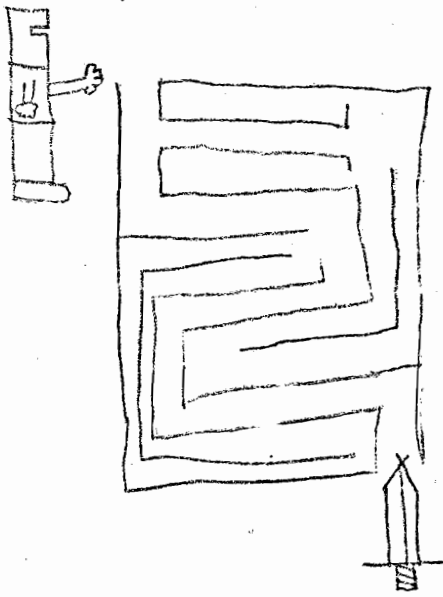
Smalls may enter any adult category, their entry will be judged as

will be determined by the greatest number of accumulated points

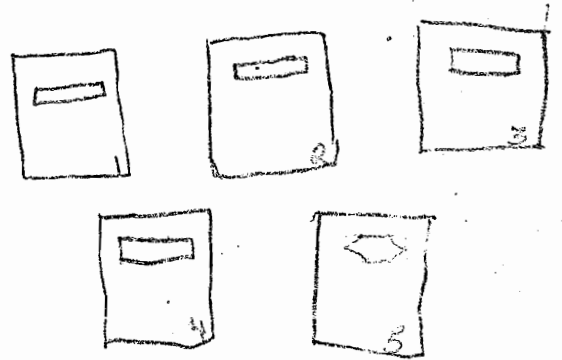
