SCHEDULE

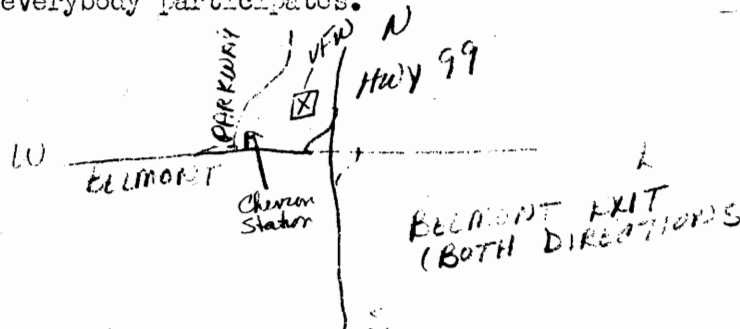

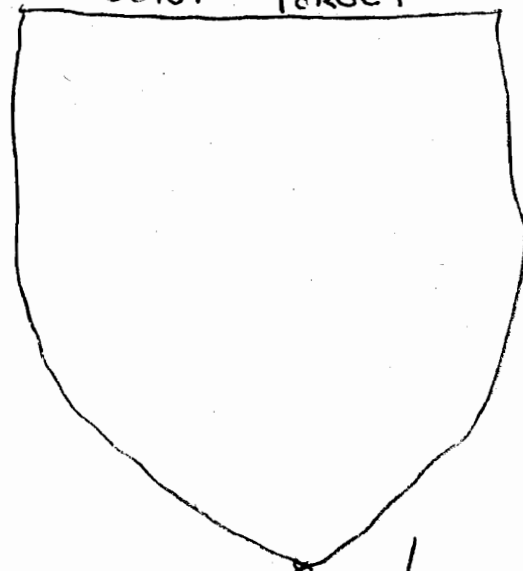
