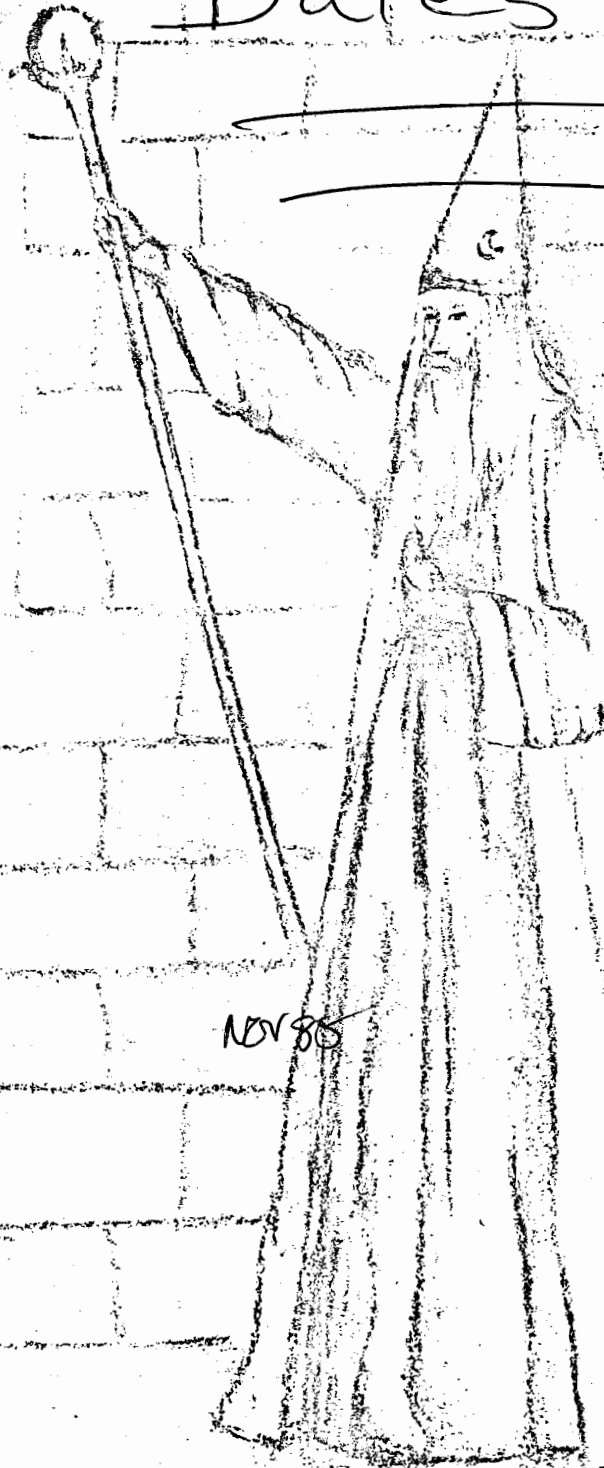

Mid-Eastern Costume by Lady Morgana

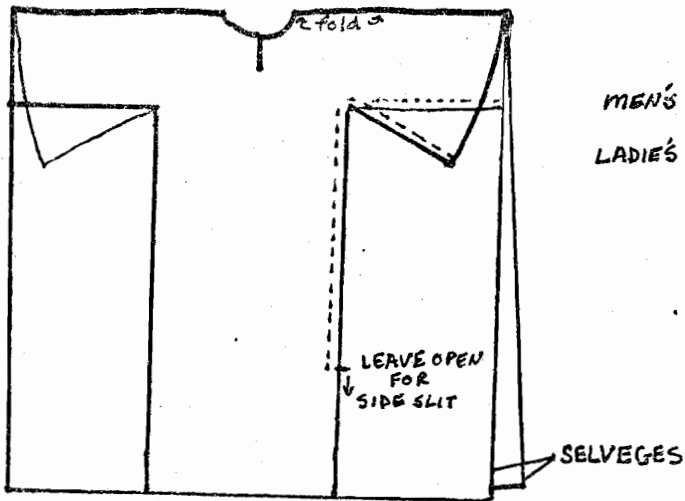
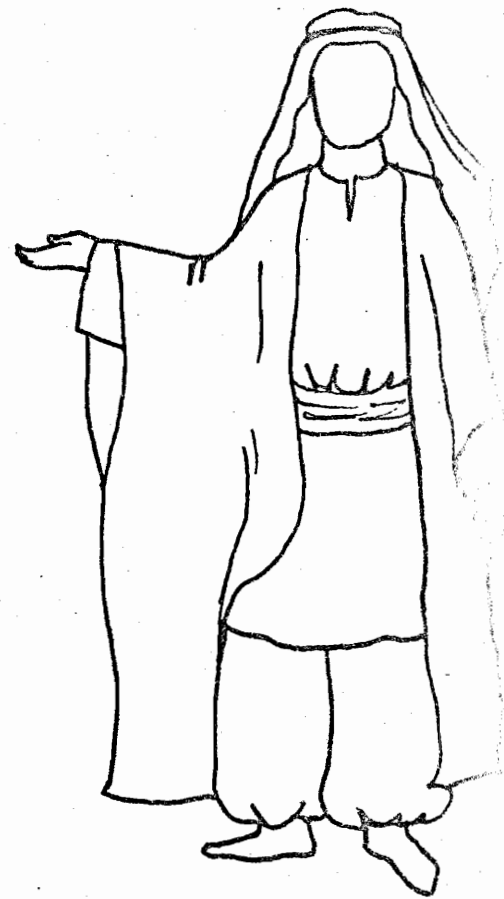


Both of these Middle Eastern outfits are simple to make. Give yourself a couple of evenings and you can easily sew one for yourself.

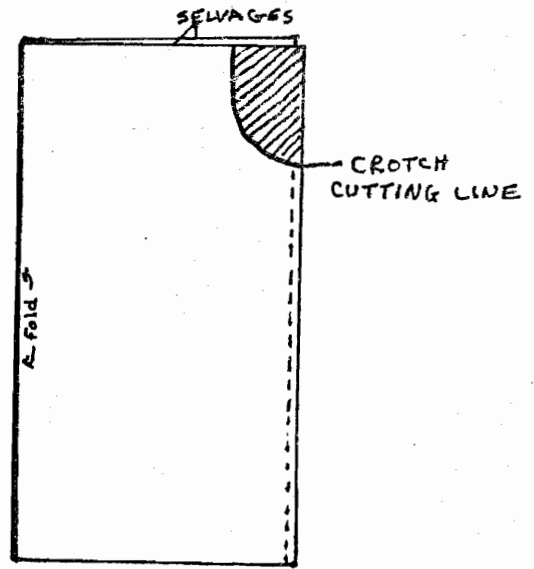
There are five basic pieces to each outfit; a long T-tunic chemise, harem pants, an outer jacket, a head scarf or turban and a sash or hip shawl. All pieces have minimum sewing.

Materials needed:
 Chemise - 2½-3 yards
 Pants - 2 yards
 Jacket - 2½-3 yards
 Scarf - 1½ yards
 Sash - 1½ yards
 Shawl - 1½ yards
 3 yards fringe (optional)

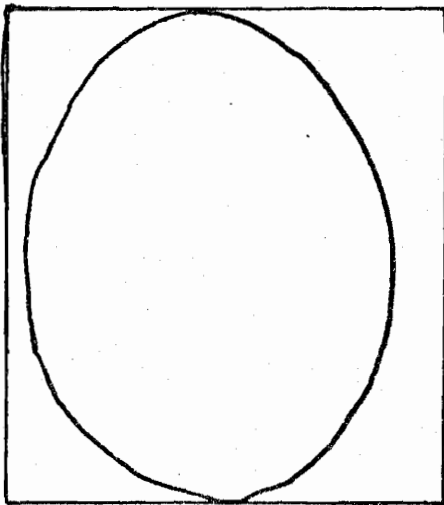

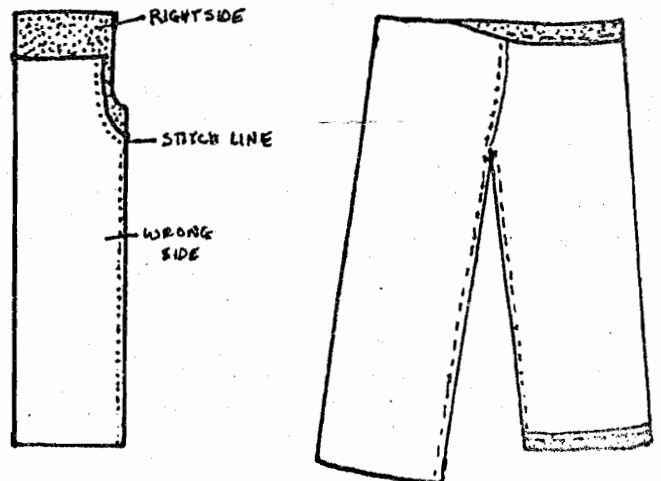
T-TUNIC

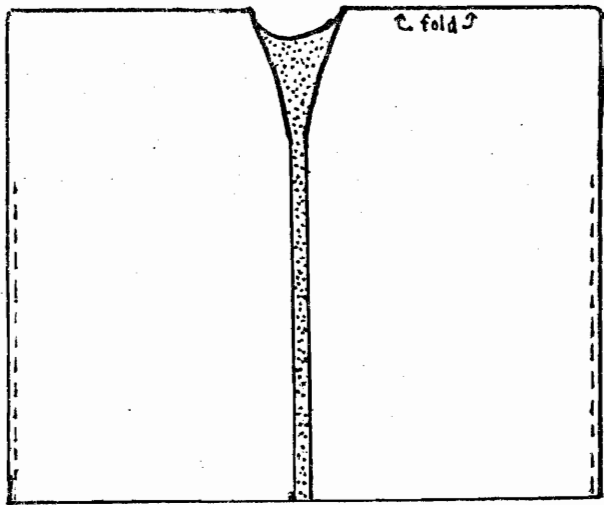


HAREM PANTS

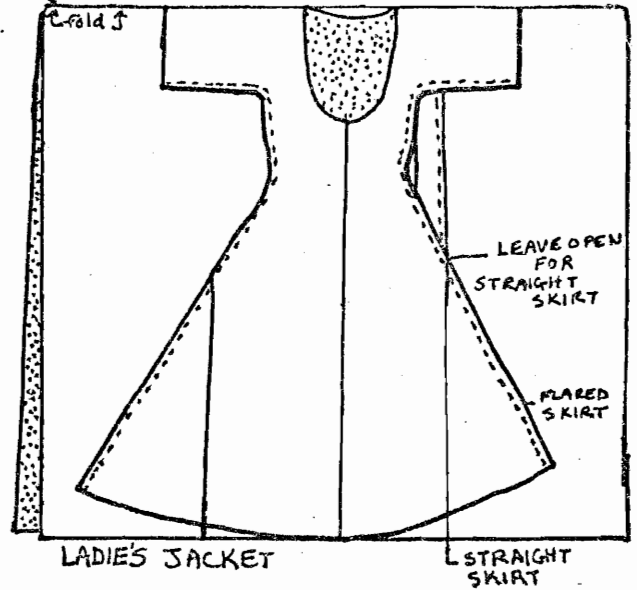


RECTANGULAR OR OVAL VEIL





MENS JACKET



T - tunic

Sew underarms and sides to top of side slit.
Hem neck, sleeves and bottom.

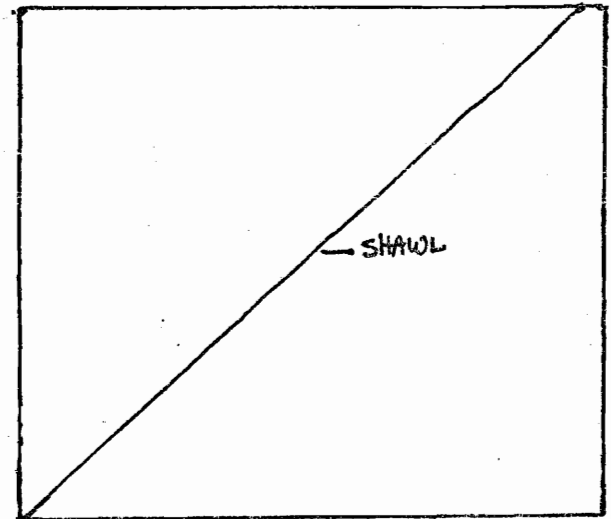
HAREM PANTS

Sew inseam. Turn one leg right side out and slip it inside the other leg. Stitch crotch. Pull leg out so pants are wrong side out. Sew waist & ankle casings and insert elastic to fit.

OUTER JACKET

Men's - cut out neck, V in front. Sew sides. Hem edges.

Women's - Decide whether you want straight or contoured sides, straight or flared skirt and cut accordingly. Cut neckline with low scoop in front. Sew underarms and sides, leaving straight skirt open from hips. Hem edges. Use buttons or pins to close front.



SHAWL & SASH

Sash - Cut lengthwise strip of fabric 8" wide. Hem edges.

Shawl - Fold fabric on diagonal and cut. Hem edges. Trim with fringe for that added touch.

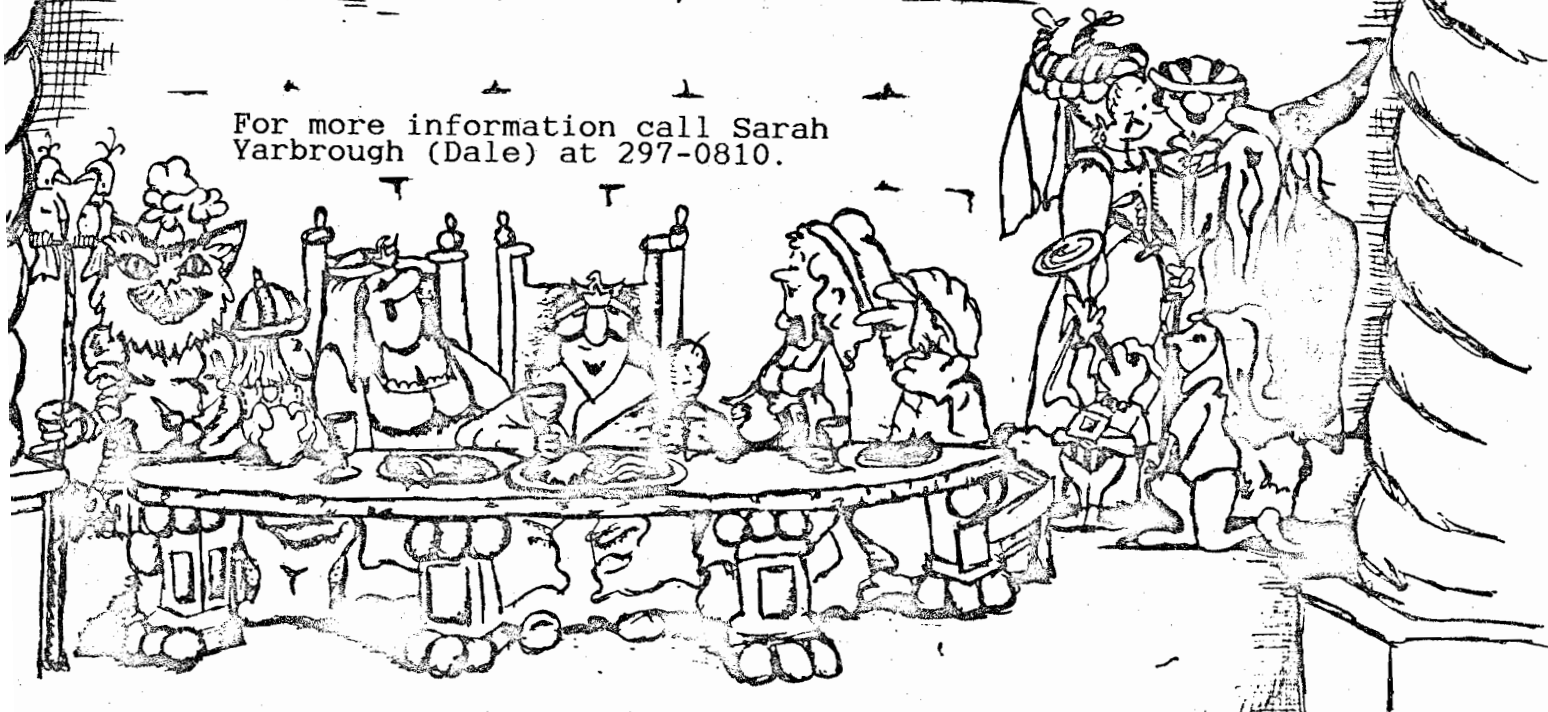
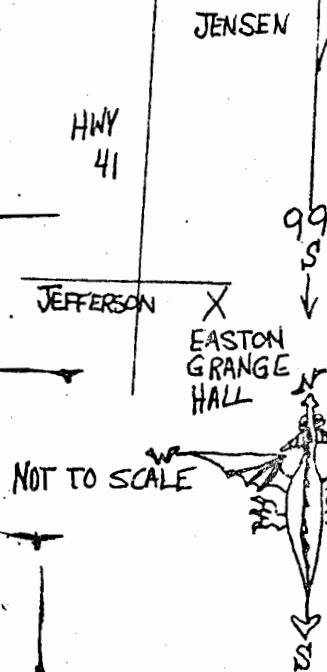
