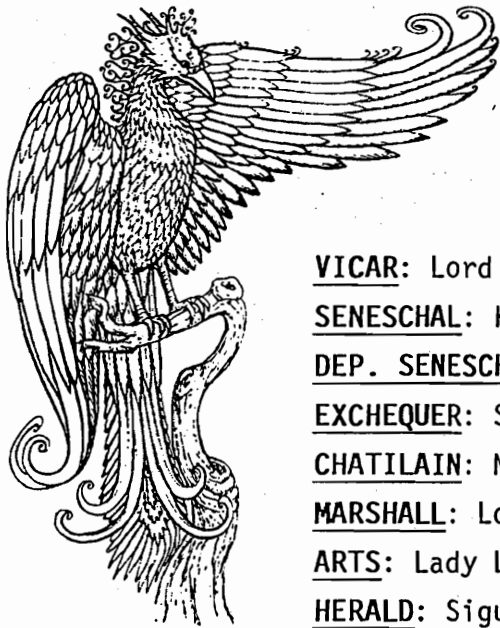

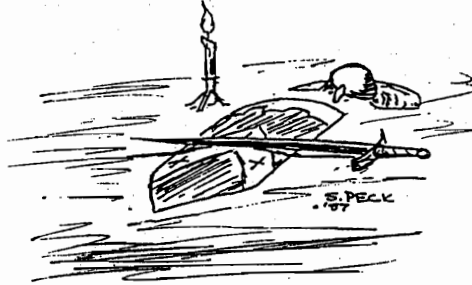

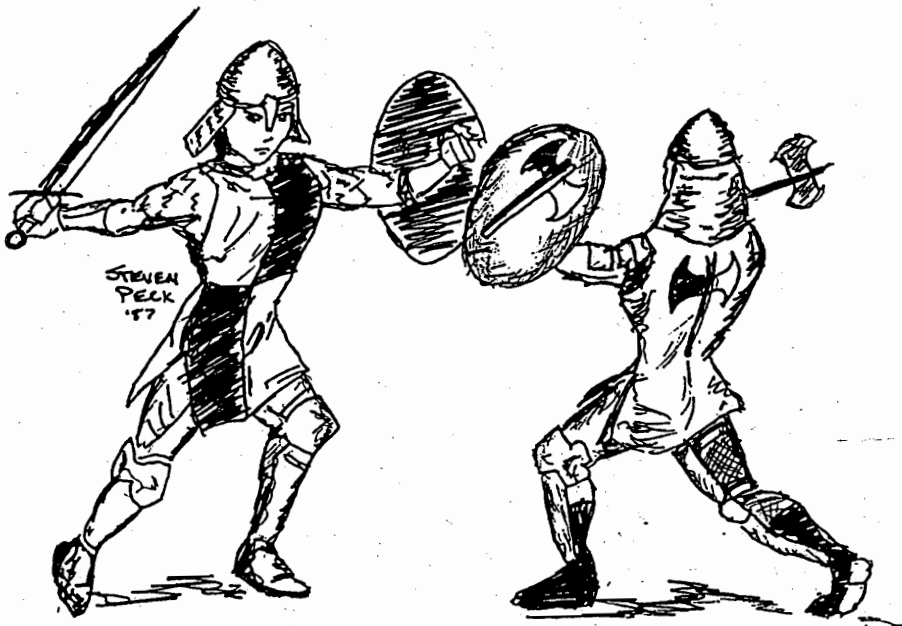
Lord Joseph of Silveroak is the current Vicar of Nordwache and holder of the Protectorate title. He is known to frequent wars and dance a lively jig.
