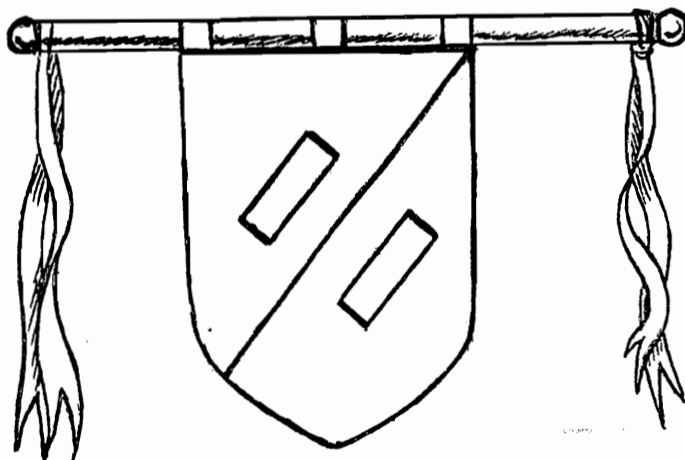

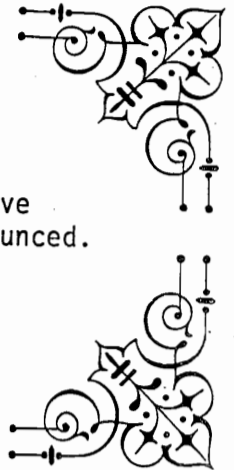
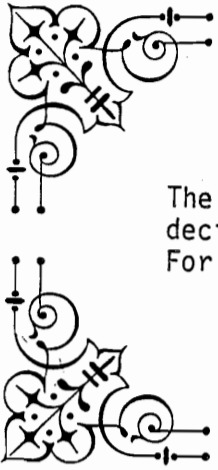

HERALDICALLY SPEAKING....

BACK TO BASICS PART III (or, Mommy I want a shield just like Daddys!)

I would first like to appologize to all of you who expected this article to be in part about furs. It isn't. The section on children as well as the section on furs grew so long that I decided to give each subject a full article. So **NEXT** article will be completely about furs.

Now onto the subject of Children and S.C.A. Heraldry;

There are several ways a child can use or display his parents arms. First let me quote you something right out of the Rules of Submissions, fourth edition (rule # AR 23; Cadency Conflict)

A. Relative allowance. A child specifically may register a device that differs only by a Mark of Cadency from one of his parents. A letter of permission shall accompany the submission. A child may display a parents device differenced by a standard mark of cadency without registering it, since this is a standard period form of display.

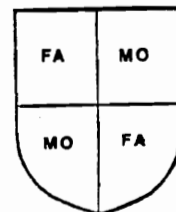
(Whew! sounds like a standard legal document!). What all this means in plain language is that a child may use one of his/her parents devices simply by adding a symbol to the device (the mark of cadency). The S.C.A. recognizes nine of the symbols the mundane english used (see figure 1) as well as the method used in Scottish heraldry.

The symbols (also called brisures, heralds do love funny names don't we?) from left to right are, the label, crescent, mullet, martlet, annulet, fleur-de-lys, rose, cross moline and the octofoil (the octofoil is not shown). Each symbol is used (in order) to show where a child stands as to inheriting the device marked. The first child would use the label, the second would use the crescent and so on. In Scottish heraldry the first generation marks are the plain bodure and the chief. Second and subsequent generations start using complex lines, putting objects in the bodure and chief, dividing the bodure and so forth. The typical way of displaying the brisures is to put them on a bodure or in any unused space, as long as it is easily visible. The label is different in that it goes across the chief. Make sure that any underlying stuff in unobscured and that the brisure follows the rules of tincture. Another way a child may display (but **NOT** register) his parents arms is to Quarter them (see figure 2). He must have both his parents permission to do this and should be encouraged to register his own device.
