

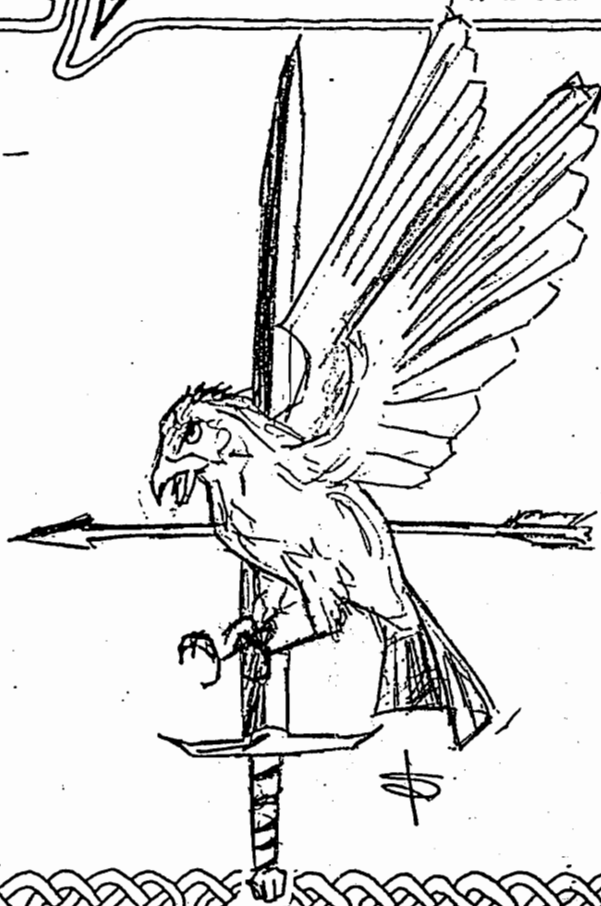

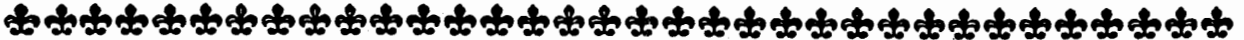

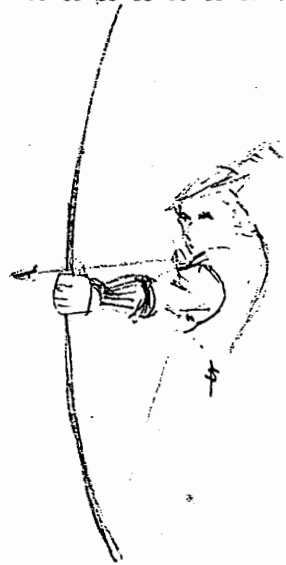

# Darkwell Wars

The declared wars between the Baronies of Altavia and Dreiburgen and between the Shire of Naevehjem and Altavia's Canton Dun Or will be held at The Indian Hill Ranch Campground in Tehachapi, California on August 12-14. The site will open at 10:00 a.m. Friday, and battles will take place all day Saturday and Sunday morning.

The site includes such attractions as HOT SHOWERS, lake swimming (no lifeguards) and fishing (bass, bluegill and catfish) with no license required, a grass meeting area, nighttime revel area with floodlights, water hookups and limited electricity. Pets are allowed but must be kept under control at all times. The altitude at the site is 5000 feet, so the nights are cool. The daytime temperatures should be in the 90 range. Hospital, grocery stores, restaurants, and service stations are in nearby Tehachapi.

Site fees for PREREGISTRATION are \$8.00 for SCA members, \$10.00 for non-members. At the gate the price will be \$10.00 for members and \$12.00 for non-members. There will be an extra \$2.00 fee for RVs. **MERCHANTS:** There will be no extra fee, but some contribution to the Kingdom coffers is encouraged. Merchants should preregister and tell us how much space will be needed. For reservations, write William of Naevehjem (see below).

I'm very excited about Nordwache's Academia. The instructors are skilled in their respective fields of study and are generous enough to share those skills with all of us. The classes that are being offered include:

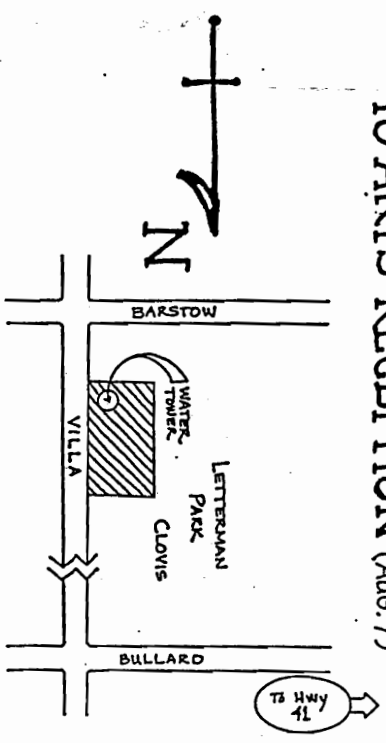
- Basic Pottery

Well thats all. Thank you for your patience and attention.

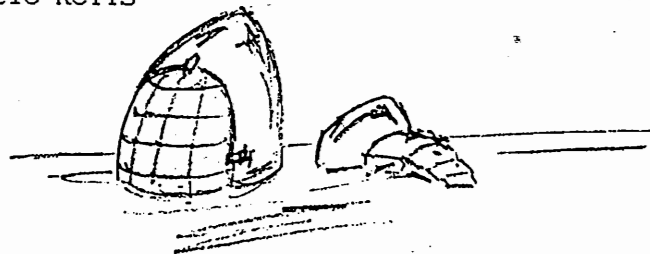
# Medieval fact - fantasy - fiction

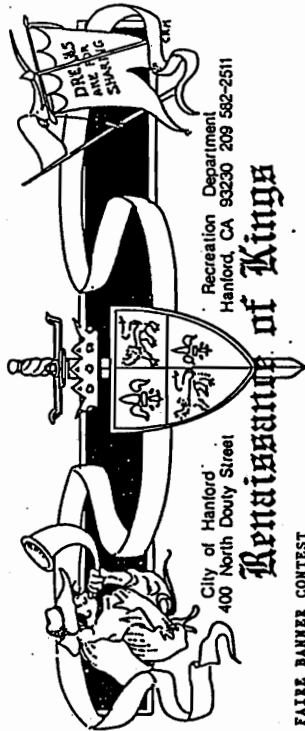
**FACT:** Ancient Ireland: Ireland's name of today has taken many turns to become what it is. The oldest known reference was made by a Greek poet named Opheus. All references and recorded names and changes were by the Latin or Greeks. Ierna - Ierne, 1st century - Iuverna, 200AD - Insula Sacra, 4th century - Scotia/Alba, 10th century - Hibernia, used by Caesar - Ivernia, race of people on the south side of the Island - Eber/Heber, 1st century Milesian king - Ir, Family in the northeastern corner of the island - Eire/Eireland, from the 1st Northmen and Saxons in the 9th and 10th centuries - Ireland.

**FANTASY:** New "Bards Tale III "Thief of Fate" \$39.95

**FICTION:** "The Medieval Knight." Illustrated weaponry of the middle ages." by David Edge & John Paddock. 200 pages of excellent photos of armor, swords, chainmail, etc. Historical references well researched ending with a valuable glossary of terms from AHLESPIESS (15th century staff weapon) to WYVERN (a Norse standard of the dark ages). #### FAIRE BANNER CONTEST

Contests were a part of the entertainment of pleasure faires in the days of yore. However, there was also a serious purpose in the competitions. Competition encouraged continual improvement among the populace in such talents as raising livestock and growing crops, domestic skills, and martial arts like archery and fighting with staves (remember when Robin Hood bested the wicked Sheriff of Nottingham's men during an archery match?).

In the tradition of friendly competition the Renaissance of Kings Cultural Arts Faire is sponsoring its 11th annual banner making contest. Banners will be used to decorate the faire site and will become the property of the Hanford City Recreation Department. A prize will be awarded.

Banners should be two feet by two feet or larger and be made of cloth. The media and forms of decorating the banner are left to the choice of the contestant. Examples are appliqué, embroidery, piecework and painting. The decoration should fit in with the faire's Renaissance era theme.

Banners should be turned into the Hanford City Recreation Office, 400 North Douy Street, 582-2511, by Friday, September 30, 1988. Or call me, Dolores Terrell, in the Fresno area at 251-9257 to make other arrangements.

Well well well.

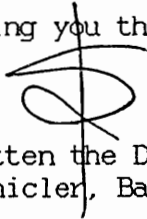
It looks like it's another month here, and I'm reasonably on time. We have a lot going on this month and I hope to see you here and there.

I'm doing something different this month. I'm doing a mailing to most every address in the Barony, to show the folks who don't subscribe to the PHEONIX what they're missing.

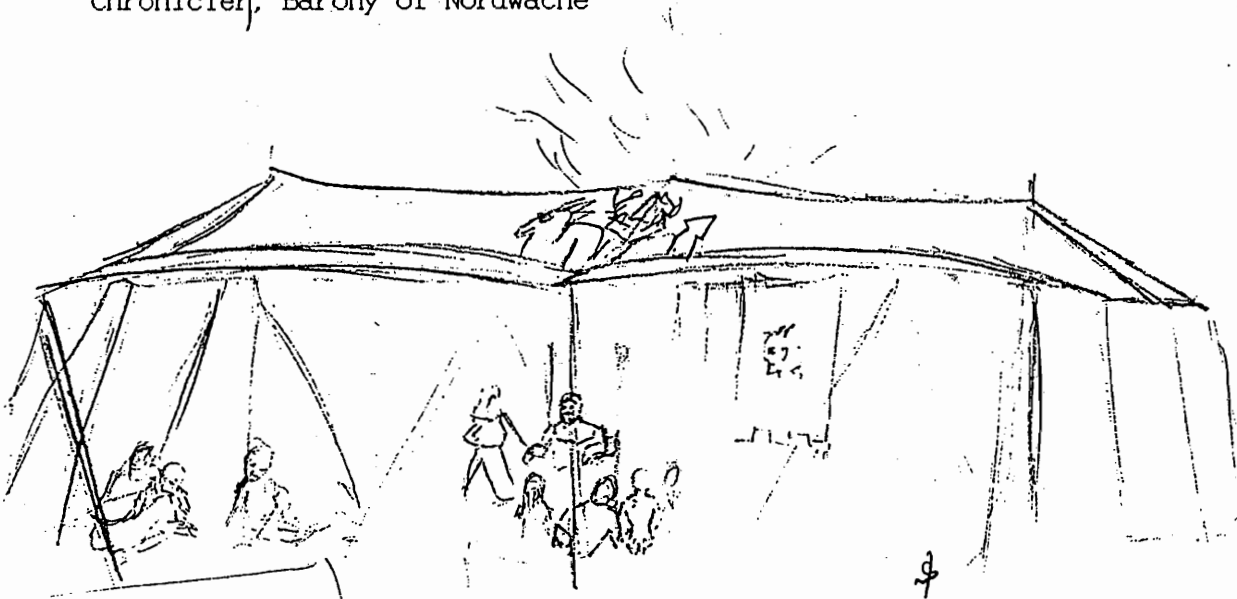
