Medieval Fact, Fantasy, and Fiction

FACT: "Motte-and-Bailey" castles were types of castles that required no skilled labor, were quick and cheap to construct, independent of considerations of terrain and could be built and fortified anywhere. The Motte or mound was steep sided, formed in part by the soil from the encircling ditch. Flat topped, one to three hundred feet in based diameter and anywhere from ten to one hundred feet high. Composed of wood, earth and stone if available. The Central keep was small, only large enough to house the Lord or commander and his family. Therefore another space below the Motte was cleared, given its own ditch and palisade and connected to the upper fort by inclined trestle and drawbridge. Sometimes, there were two or three lower court or bailey's connected to the Motte.

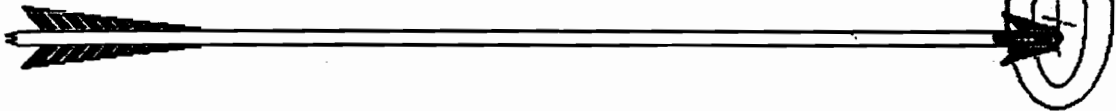

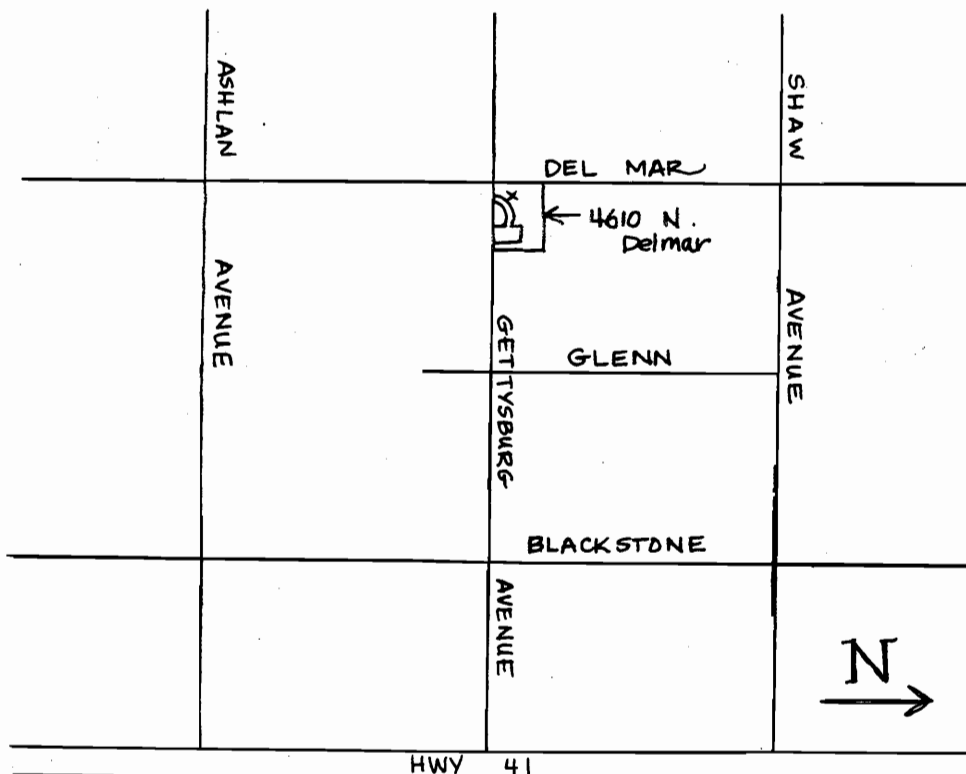
