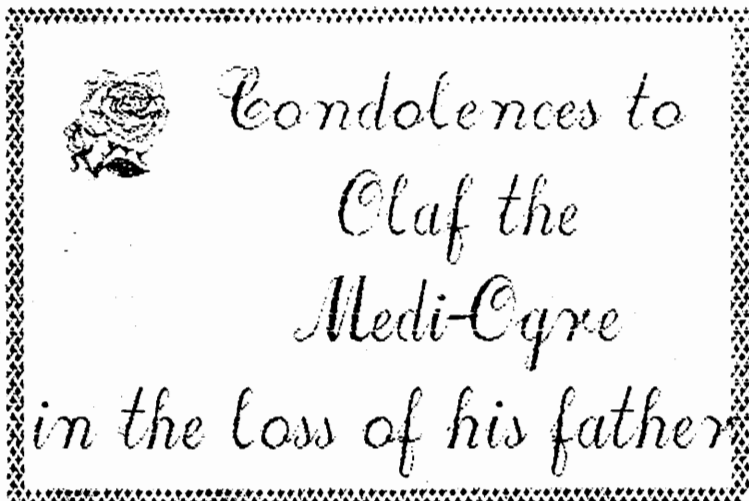
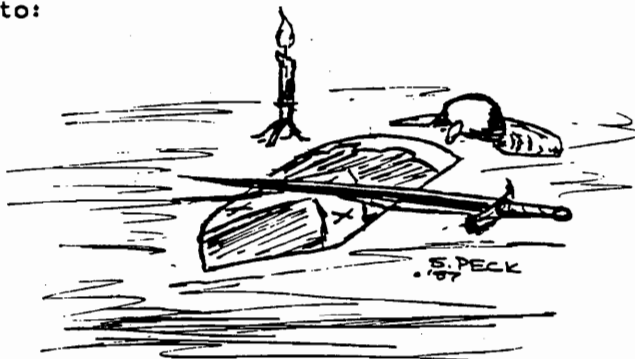
NAME THAT DOG
