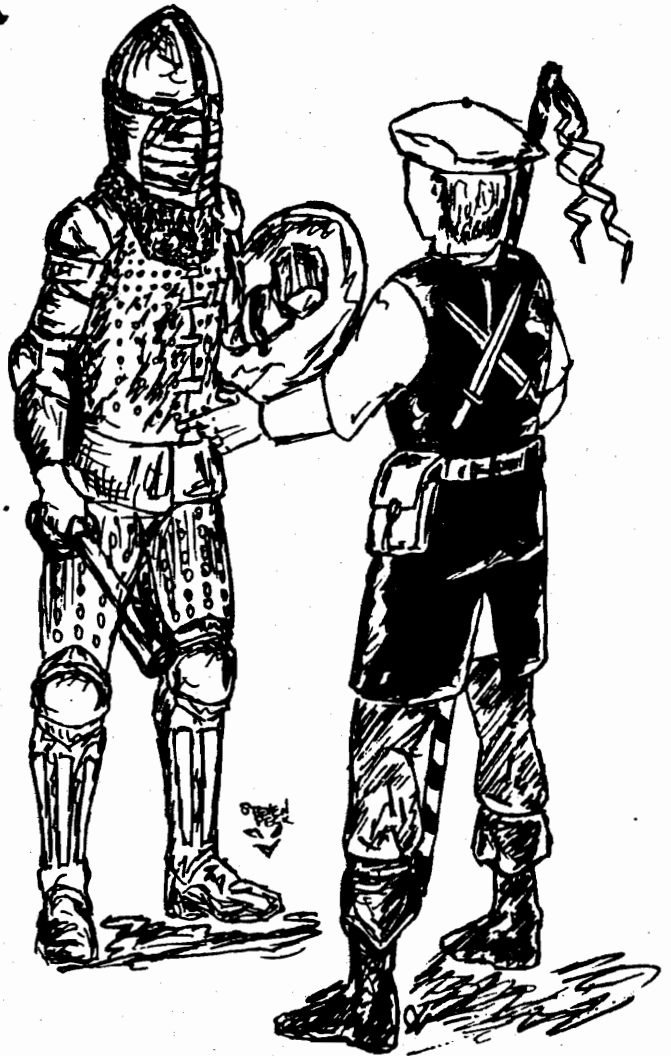

Avaunt Courier;

This officer is our mundane media connection. They advertise events and publicize the local S C A. They maintain contacts with the local news organizations and try to get reporters to visit our events. This office is a vital link in gaining new members.

Constable;

This officer works mostly at events. They man the gate, operate as liaison with local law enforcement during an event, maintain order at events (in a nice and polite way) and keep the local lost and found.

Chatelaine;

This officer basically takes care of newcomers. They keep a list of local events, hold newcomer's meetings and, at events, show newcomers around and help them become integrated with the S C A.

Another office which has come open lately is Historian. While this is only a local position, it is still important. The Historian keeps the local area's archives and maintains a photo album of past events.

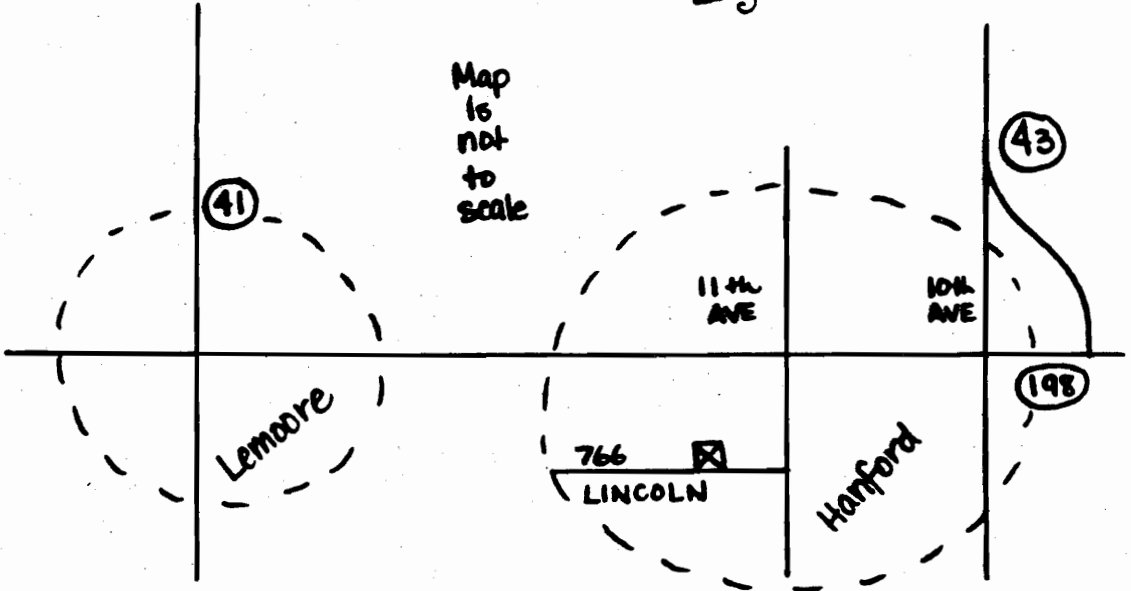

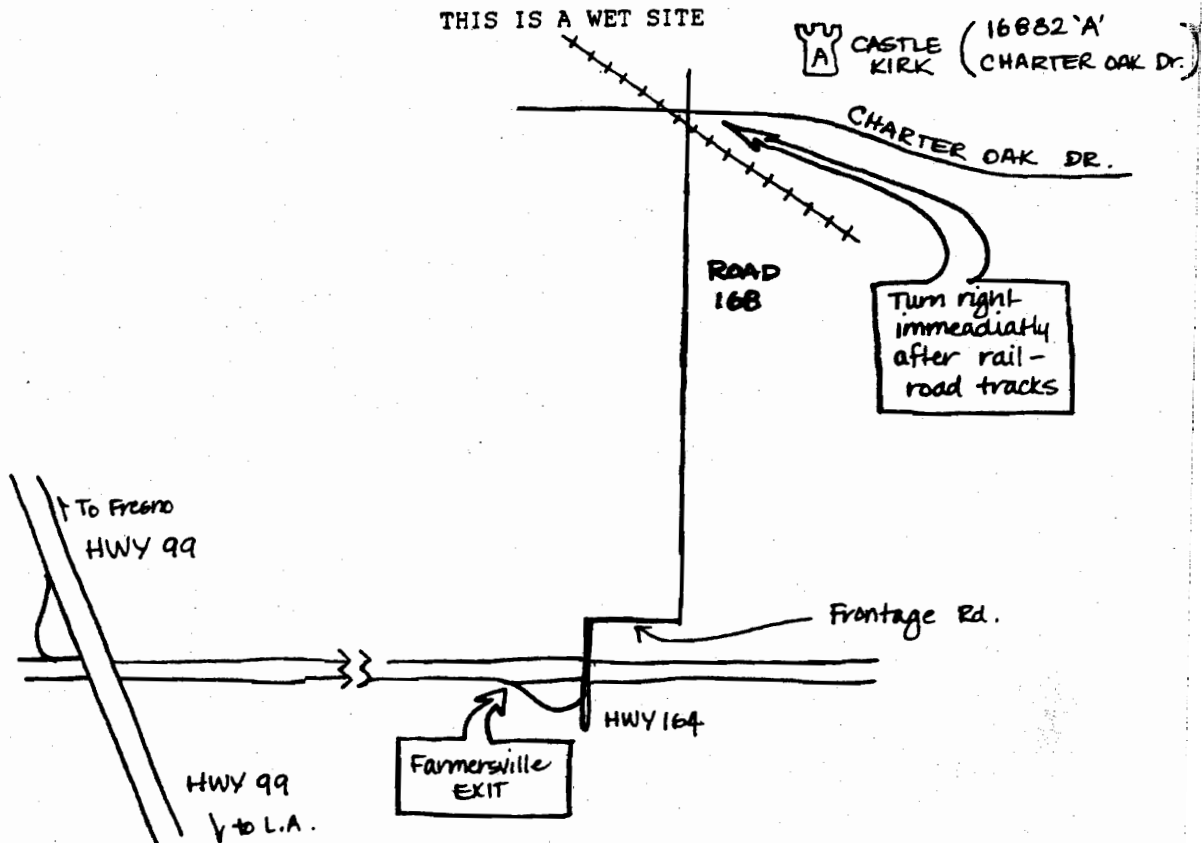

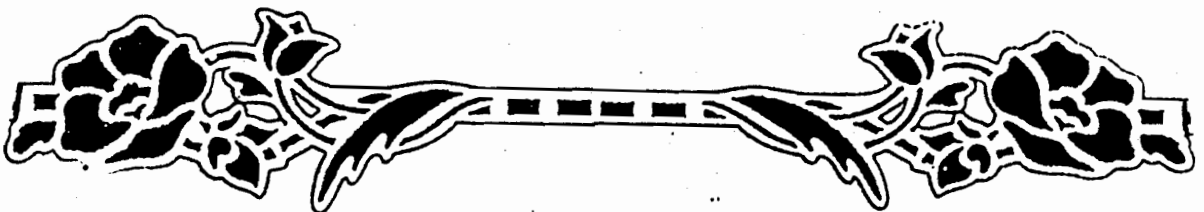


Here We Go Again.
