Come and enjoy a day and night of revelry in a celebration of the many varied times and lands which exists within the dream. The theme of this year's celebration is an Argent and Sable Masque Ball. Those wishing to aid and assist should contact the Autocrat, Lord Lewis Whitaker (Henry Whitaker), at Farspeck (209) 674-3060. A scribe will take your message if the lord and lady of the manor are occupied.

We will hold the day of celebrations at one of our finest inns (The Ramada Inn, Fresno). A special flat rate of \$46.00 per room (maximum of four persons per room) is being charged; to place your reservations please contact: RAMADA INN OF FRESNO, 324 E. SHAW AVE, FRESNO, CA 93710 [PHONE (209) 224-4040] and identify the Society, date and event.

Our Feast-O-Crat, Genevieve of Osborne's Glade (Jenny Raddatz, (209) 454-1707) is planning with the inn's chef to host a great day of feasting and revelry. The cost for the feast is \$15.00 a person, there will be a no host bar, NO ALCOHOL CAN BE BROUGHT INTO THE BANQUET FROM THE HOSPITALITY SUITE!!! This is the inn's policy and is non-negotiable.

The site fee for the event will be \$10.00 a person (those sending in their reservations prior to December 15, 1989 will have lunch included at NO COST). Smalls 5 and under are FREE; ages 6-12 are half price (\$5.00 site fee and \$7.50 for the feast). Non members pay \$2.50 extra each for site fee and feast. Proof of current membership is required for the lower cost (cancelled check to Registrar, membership card, label from kingdom newsletter). Space is limited for the feast to no more than 250 people, so register EARLY!! Deadline for registration for feast and luncheon is 15 December 1989. Deadline for merchants is 30 November 1989.

Merchants may rent spaces for \$15.00 per 10' x 10' space. Spaces will be located in the Grand Foyer Entrance and the hall between Court and the privies (there is limited access to electrical power). Advanced reservation cutoff is November 30, 1989; "at the door spaces" will be \$25.00 per 10'x10', on a first come basis (if there are any left). 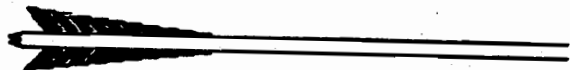

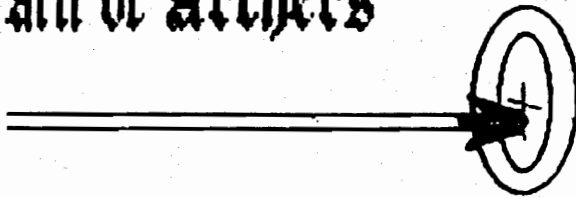

I would also like to state for the record that the Thursday night practices usually held at the range of the Brotherhood of the Otherwood is now cancelled due to lack of LIGHT. Sundays practice is currently being held at the same time which is 12:00 NOON. Call me for location. For those archers or soon to be archers we have established two new ranges (well 1 and 1/2). One has been located in Clovis at 8236 N. Armstrong. Dir. Go east on Herndon Ave. until you hit Armstrong, Take a left and head north until you reach the stop sign. At the stop you will notice a green and white sign that says Nees ave. If you do not see this sign you made a wrong turn somewhere and I strongly suggest that you read these directions again before proceeding. At Nees ave. you will continue north on Armstrong until the third driveway then you will need to make a right into this driveway to get to the range. You will note that there are two palm trees and a little sign that say "HONEY", again if you do not see these landmarks I am pointing out to you DO NOT turn right in the driveway to go to the range, instead pull the chariot over and read these directions again. 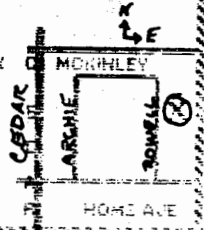
